Where Does a Rabbit Live?

Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. Forests provide shade and plants to eat, while deserts require rabbits to adapt by finding water in plants and staying cool with their large ears.
2. Rabbits are good at surviving because they can dig burrows for safety, adapt to different climates, and find food in many environments.
3. Wild rabbits live in nature and face predators, while pet rabbits live with humans and are protected. Both need food, space, and places to hide.
4. If rabbits didn't have places to hide, they would be more vulnerable to predators and wouldn't survive as well in the wild.
