## How Do Zebras Move?

### Short Answer Key

1. Zebras can run up to 40 miles per hour to escape predators.
2. Zebras use a zigzag running pattern to confuse predators chasing them.
3. Zebras' hooves help them survive by allowing them to walk on rough terrain and kick predators when threatened.
4. Zebras travel in herds to protect themselves, as a group is harder for predators to attack than a single zebra.
5. Yes, zebras can swim, and they might do it to migrate or escape from predators.
